Emerging artist Kevin Layton graduated from Eastern Oregon University in 2006. He has been the Education Director at Custer County Art and Heritage Center in Miles City since 2008.

Layton works with a variety of media in painting, drawing, printmaking, and ceramics. A process oriented playful kind of guy, he enjoys exploring ideas and materials, as much, as the finished product.

Always finding and incorporating found objects and recycling unique raw materials, Kevin’s artwork is very conceptual and he lets this show through his multi-layered images.

There will be an opening reception for artist Kevin Layton on Sunday, February 7th from 3 – 5 PM. This gathering is free and open to the public. Please join us to meet the artist, for conversation, and refreshments.
