Growing Eastern Montana (GEM) – tuition rate applies to students who are residents of North Dakota, South Dakota, and Wyoming, and is equivalent to the installer state.

Western Undergraduate Exchange (WUE) - students enroll in out of state college at a reduced tuition level. Residents from the following states may participate if eligible: Alaska, Arizona, California, Colorado, Hawaii, Idaho, Nevada, New Mexico, Oregon, Utah and Washington. Residents from the following Commonwealth of Northern Marianas Islands may participate if eligible: American Samoa, Northern Marianas, Guam Marshal Islands, Federated States of Micronesia and Palau.

CANADIAN EXCHANGE – Under the Canadian Exchange Program, residents from the following provinces may participate, if eligible: Alberta, British Columbia, Manitoba and Saskatchewan.

All students residing in campus housing are required to purchase a meal plan. If no option is made, students are assigned the least expensive option.

Students have the ability to add funds to meal accounts if needed.
