WUE – Under the Western Undergraduate Exchange (WUE) program, students enroll at a reduced tuition level. Residents from the following states or territories may participate if eligible: Alaska, Arizona, California, Colorado, Hawaii, Idaho, Nevada, New Mexico, Oregon, Utah, and Washington. Residents from the following Commonwealth of Northern Marianas Islands may participate if eligible: American Samoa, Northern Marianas, Guam, Marshal Islands, Federated States of Micronesia, and Palau.

Canadian Exchange – Under the Canadian Exchange Program, residents from the following provinces may participate, if eligible: Alberta and British Columbia.
