ELIGIBILITY CONSIDERATIONS

 a. An honorably discharged veteran of any of the United States or Canadian armed forces having served between January 1, 1960 to the present, or any currently active serving member of said Armed Forces, or their spouse, child, stepchild, or descendent with preference being given to Vietnam veteran related candidates.

b. The spouse, widow/widower, child, stepchild, or descendent of any military serviceperson killed in the line of duty, MIA or POW with preference being given to Vietnam veteran related candidates.

2. The application must be a resident of Montana, Wyoming, North Dakota or Canada.

- 3. The applicant must have maintained a 2.0 grade point average in high school or the last college semester prior to the semester applied for the scholarship.
- 4. The scholarship may be used in any field of study at Dawson Community College.
- 5. The applicant must maintain full-time status, that is, maintain a minimum of 12 credits per semester.
- 6. The Scholarship is for one year only and will be disbursed with one half in each fall and spring semesters as per the Dawson College Foundation guidelines. Proceeds from scholarships must be used to pay college tuition expenses or the costs of books.
- 7. The qualified scholarship applicants will be determined by a college selection committee who will follow the guidelines set forth by Glendive Chapter #234 of the VVA. GUIDELINES: Once the selection committee identifies the top candidates, the list of up to 6 applications will be sent to Glendive Chapter #234 who will recommend their choice. Glendive Chapter #234 reserves the right to reject any and all applicants.
