O Vietnam Era Veteran

O Veteran - other

O Disabled Veteran

A person entitled to disability compensation under laws administered by the Veterans Administration for disability rated at 30 percent or more or a person whose discharge or release from active duty was for a disability incurred or aggravated in the line of duty.

Handicapped - Disabled

Any person who has a physical or mental impairment which substantially limits one or more major life activities, has a record of such impairment. "Major life activities" means functions such as caring for one's self, performing manual tasks, walking, seeing, hearing, speaking, breathing, learning, and working.
