Get Started

- Application Fee** - If you have not paid the application fee or \$30, call or mail us a check.
- Transcripts** - Submit final high school and/or college transcripts/HiSet/GED scores. Transcripts must be mailed or delivered in the original envelope to be considered official.
- Immunization Records** - Provide proof of two immunizations for measles, mumps, and rubella (MMR).
- ACT/SAT** - If you have taken a standardized test, please submit your scores. If you have not, plan to take our standardized test.
- Financial Assistance** - Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at www.fafsa.edu.gov to qualify for federal aid, state student loans, institutional scholarships, and work study.
NOTE: DCC's school code is 002529.
- Scholarships** - To find a complete listing of institutional scholarships, go to www.dawson.edu/future/financial-aid/scholarships.
