

# CP 3-10: Mandatory Housing Residency

Full-time students who are seeking a degree and/or a certificate are required to live on-campus.

Exemptions to this policy are based on the following criteria:

- Students who reside with their parent(s), grandparents, or legal guardian within a 80-mile radius of campus
- Married students or students with dependents
- Age 21 prior to the first official day of classes for the semester in which they are enrolling
- Students who are solely registered for Distance Education courses or programs

Students may request an exemption, by filling out the Mandatory Housing Residency Exemption Request Form with appropriate supporting documentation. Upon completion of the form, the appealing committee, approved by the President, will review and provide a final decision.

Minor children of students are prohibited from living in student housing.

**SCOPE**            This policy applies to Dawson Community College.

**PROCEDURES**    The College President shall promulgate such procedures as may be needed to implement this policy.
