



Getting Deeper into Microsoft Excel

This hands-on course, *Digging Deeper into Microsoft Excel, 2013*, picks up where the *Getting Started with Microsoft Excel* left off. This course assumes the student has some experience with formulas and functions, and the various data types. Students will learn terminology and concepts and perform calculations using formulas and functions using challenging exercises.

- Boolean Values (TRUE, FALSE)
- Nested IF Statements
- Conditional Formatting
- Lookup functions
- Payment functions
- Using Multiple Worksheets
